Scenario Based Questions

Behaviors that Demonstrate:

Leadership

Initiative and Follow Through

Thinking and Problem Solving



"Tell me about a time when you accomplished something significant that would not have happened if you had not been there to make it happen."



Leadership



"Tell me about a goal that you set that took a long time to achieve or that you are still working toward."



Initiative and Follow Through



"Tell me about a time when you had to analyze facts quickly, define key issues, and respond immediately or develop a plan that produced good results."



Thinking and Problem Solving



Scenario Based Questions

Behaviors that Demonstrate:

Communication

Decision Making

Ability to Work in Varying Work Conditions



"Tell me about a situation where you had to be persuasive and sell your idea to someone else."



Communication



"Tell me about a time when you were tolerant of an opinion that was different than your own."



Communication



"Tell me about a time when you were forced to make an unpopular decision."



Decision Making



"Tell me about a time when you worked effectively under pressure."



Ability to work in varying work conditions



Scenario Based Questions

Difficult Interview Questions:

Examples:

- Why were you laid off?
- How much money do you want?
- What do you think of your boss?

What Questions Should I Ask?

Interviewers will ask similar questions

Examples:

- 1. What are your strengths and weaknesses?
- 2. What are your major accomplishments?
- Have 3-5 questions ready to ask

Examples:

- 1. What qualities do you think are necessary to be successful in the role?
- 2. What is your favorite aspect of working for this company?



Questions to Refrain From

What is your turnover rate?

Will I be working a lot of overtime?

How soon can I move up to a management position?

Can you tell me what my compensation will be?



The Good and the Bad





The Good



- Arrive 15 minutes early
- Prepare questions ahead of time
- Be enthusiastic
- Appear flexible and open to opportunities presented
- Turn off your cell phone

The Bad



- Chewing gum
- Smoke before an interview
- Refuse a job offer in the interview
- Talk negatively about a previous employer
- Be dishonest
